**Dirty River** Founded in 1982 and features Jenelle Murray, Jeff Bonta and Rick "Rock" Stone. They pack clubs to the walls. In early 1992 Dirty River decided to use the large baseball fields at the Township Fields and Tavern they were playing for Cincinnati's very first blues festival celebrating the best blues Cincinnati had to offer then including such local stars as the Blues All-Stars ("Big Ed" Thompson, Ricky Nye, John "Hammer" Sampson), "Sweet" Alice Hoskins, and more. As a regular on blues radio, Dirty River played with "Pigmeat" Jarret, Joe Duskin and others.
